Betty A. (Hartman) Blankenberger, 90, of Cynthiana, IN passed away Sunday, April 29, 2018 at her home.

Betty was born in Evansville in 1927 to the late Alphonse and Margaret (Hetzel) Hartman. She was a homemaker and a member of St. Wendel Catholic Church, the Ladies Sodality at St. Wendel and the SPRED group for disabled children at St. Joseph Catholic Church. She quilted with Quilters for Christ at the United Church of Christ and the Schoolhouse Quilters in Princeton. She hosted exchange students from Mexico, Germany, Brazil, and Pakistan.
