Ruth Olga Rice, 100, of Evansville, passed away Thursday, August 27, 2020 at the Pine Haven Health and Rehabilitation Center.

Ruth was born at home in Evansville to the late Walter V. and Amelia (Vogel) Stippler on March 9, 1920. Ruth's love of family was always number one on her list. She retired from teaching to take care of her children; help coach her sons' sports and be their Cub Scout and Boy Scout leader. Ruth also volunteered as a Brownie and Girl Scout leader for her daughters. She and her late husband, C. Thomas Rice, traveled and camped in all of the 48 contiguous states. Later they traveled to see their grandchildren's and great grandchildren's sporting events, dance recitals, graduations, wedding and religious milestones. Ruth was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Vanderburgh County.

Ruth attended Memorial High School and was a graduate of the Ferdinand Academy. She graduated in 1942 with a degree in elementary education from Evansville College while serving as president of the Phi Mu Sorority. While in college, Ruth learned how to pilot an airplane.
