Aaron Joseph Schnur, 40, of Evansville, passed away at his home on Sunday, October 9, 2022 after a long battle with cystic fibrosis.

Aaron was born in Evansville, IN on March 12, 1982 to Steve Schnur and Jolene (Steinkamp) Groves. He worked as an occupational therapist prior to becoming disabled. Aaron loved music; he was a drummer, played guitar and loved to sing karaoke.
