Adriene H. Reiner, 85, of Evansville, passed away on Friday, December 13, 2024, at her home surrounded by family.

Adriene was born on October 9, 1939 in Amsterdam, Netherlands to the late Johaness and Johanna (Van Dolen) Hoven. She, along with her family, fled to safety in the United States during World War II. Adriene worked very hard to become a United States citizen and was very proud of accomplishing that goal in the 1980s. Adriene worked as a bookkeeper and did shorthand before staying home to raise her six children. After her children were grown, she went back to work driving a special needs bus for the Evansville Vanderburgh School Corporation for 23 years. Adriene was a member of SWIRCA. She enjoyed listening to music, crafting and embroidery. She also loved to dance.

Surviving Adriene are daughters, Christine Reiner, Cathy Reiner and Virginia Roby; sons, Mark (Rhonda) Reiner, Craig (Kay) Reiner and Donald Reiner; ten grandchildren, Megan and Kevin Reiner, John and Evan Reiner, Brandi and Ashley Shepherd, Sean and Amber Reiner and Madison and Bailey Roby and two great grandchildren.

In addition to her parents, Adriene was preceded in death by her former husband and father of her children, Ron Reiner; by sisters, Margaret Ridderbos and Cornelia Leegstra and by a brother, John Hoven.

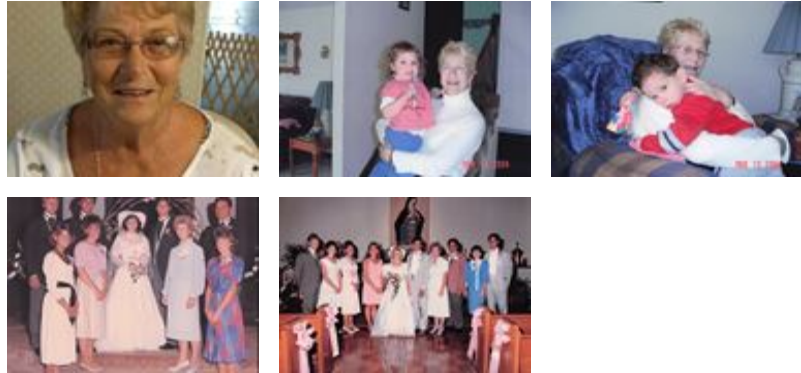
