Agnes J. “Jo” Miller, 82, of Evansville, passed away Saturday, January 11, 2020 at Transcendent Healthcare in Boonville.

Jo was born April 18, 1937 in Pontiac, IL the fourth child of Joe and Mabel (Bartlett) Whalen. She was a graduate of Pontiac High School and attended St. Mary’s College, Notre Dame, IN. On June 2, 1956, Jo married Paul A. Miller of South Bend, IN. They lived in New Jersey and LaPorte, IN before settling in Evansville in 1962.

Jo worked at Plumbing and Industrial Supply and Erdmann Corporation before joining Mead Johnson Nutritionals in 1979 where she served as a secretary in many different departments before retiring in 2001. She later worked part time at the University of Southern Indiana before retiring for good in May of 2006.

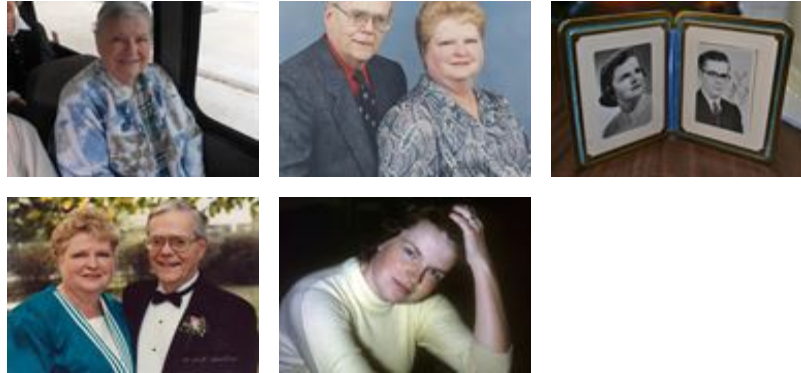
