July 15, 1921 - March 16, 2013

Agnes Regina "Jean" (Lynn) Klingler, age 91, of Evansville, passed away Saturday, March 16, 2013 at Pine Haven Health and Rehabilitation Center.

A lifelong resident of Evansville, Jean participated in the war effort as a "Rosie the Riveter", building P47 Thunderbolts at the Republic Aviation plant. For several years thereafter, she worked as one of only two women Claims Agents in the United States for Hancock Trucking of Evansville. Following a brief career as a real estate agent, she opened Jean's Suburban Ceramics. Jean received multiple certifications as an instructor in ceramics and for 20 years she shared her creative passion with hundreds of students, many of whom became her close friends. She was a long-time member of St. Benedict Cathedral and a 1939 graduate of Memorial High School.

Surviving are her husband of 54 years, Alfred Klingler; three sons, Glenn Hicks of Salt Lake City, UT, Jeffrey Klingler of Antioch, CA and Timothy (Becky) Klingler of Evansville; a daughter-in-law, Rosemary Hicks; thirteen grandchildren, Jennifer (Thomas Huggins) Hicks, Elizabeth Delano, Jim (Liz Creech) Hicks, Joseph Hicks, Matt (Tracy Bee) Hicks, Rebecca (Kelly) Green, Karen (Eric) McDonald, Michael (Jackie) Hicks, Tina (Derrick) Barrett, Bryan Hicks, Anne (Jeremy) Weiner, Kevin (Courtney) Tooke and Katelyn Klingler and twenty two great grandchildren.
