Alan Dean Hert, 60, of Evansville, passed away Wednesday, April 23, 2008 at IU Med Center University Hospital.

Mr. Hert was an active member of Holy Redeemer Catholic Church volunteering in many activities in the church and also volunteered with the American Diabetes Association. He was a 4th Degree Knight in the Knights of Columbus at the church and a member of the Board of Directors at Centurion Federal Credit Union. He was an avid sports fan; he loved to play, coach and watch and was an avid reader. Alan was a graduate of Reitz High School and the University of Evansville, where he also received his master's degree.
