Albert F. Scheu, Jr., 72, of Mt. Vernon, passed away Wednesday, November 22, 2017 at his home surrounded by family.

Al was born June 21, 1945 in Evansville to the late Albert F. and Thelma (Lawrence) Scheu, Sr. He had worked at Bristol Myers Squibb before retiring in 2003 after 36 years of service. Al was a longtime member of St. Philip Catholic Church and the St. Philip Men's Club. In his younger years, Al spent time coaching his children's athletic teams and more recently enjoyed attending his grandchildren's events. He loved the New York Yankees and Mater Dei athletics.
