



Alberta Fehrenbacher

March 16, 1918 - November 4, 2009

Alberta Regina (Benkert) Fehrenbacher, age 91, of Evansville, passed away on Wednesday, November 4, 2009 surrounded by her family.

Mrs. Fehrenbacher had been a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Vanderburgh County since 1939, a member of the St. Ann's Altar Society at the church and had held office in the St. Joe Senior Citizens program since its inception. Alberta was a loving wife, mother and grandmother who enjoyed vegetable and flower gardening.
