Alfred B. Knapp, 89, of Evansville, passed away Friday, February 19, 2021 at Solarbron Terrace with his family by his side.

Al was born February 24, 1931 in Evansville to the late William and Olivia (Tenbarge) Knapp. He worked as a tool and die maker for Moll Tool and Die, Kent Plastics and Ball Plastics, was a 1949 graduate of Memorial High School, an active member of Resurrection Catholic Church, a Grand Knight in the Knights of Columbus and an avid supporter of Mater Dei Men's Club, USI Varsity Club and Mater Dei Booster Club. Al enjoyed bowling and was a knife collector.
