Allen G. Halbig, 92, of Haubstadt, passed away on Friday, November 22, 2024 at Bethel Manor.

Allen was born on August 28, 1932 in Haubstadt, the only child of the late Delphin and Vernita (Greubel) Halbig. He was a lifelong resident of Haubstadt and a 1950 graduate of Haubstadt High School. He married Lucille Lamey on September 12, 1953 and they were married for 70 years prior to her passing on January 1, 2024.

Allen was a longtime member of Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Haubstadt and the Knights of Columbus. He retired from Emge Meat Packing after over 30 years of service.
