Allen J. Herrmann, 73, of Evansville, passed away Tuesday, June 20, 2017 at Select Specialty Hospital.

Allen was born January 14, 1944 in Evansville to the late Clarence J. and Lorena (Nurrenbern) Herrmann. He worked for Canadian National Illinois Central Railway for 41 years before retiring. Allen was a member of Resurrection Catholic Church and a veteran of the United States Army National Guard. He was active in the Mater Dei Men's Club, the R-Men's Club and the Resurrection Men's Club. Allen loved visiting in the morning at the Donut Bank, attending his grandchildren's sporting events and fishing.

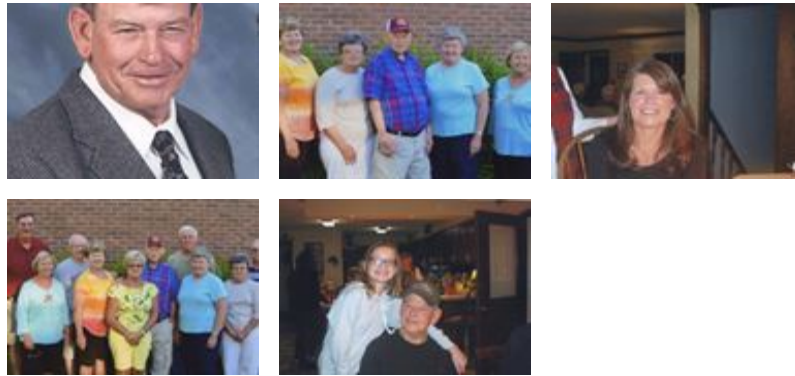

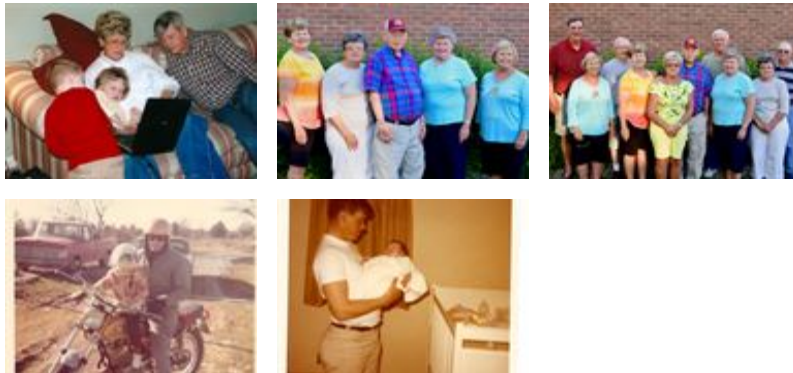
