Allen J. Swain, age 79, of Evansville, passed away Friday, February 24, 2012 at his home.

Mr. Swain was a self-employed contractor, cabinet maker and carpenter. Allen was a member of St. Boniface Catholic Church and a former member of Resurrection Catholic Church.
