Alvin Leo Paul, 71, of Newburgh, passed away Friday, February 1, 2019 surrounded by family at the home of his daughter in Hendersonville, TN.

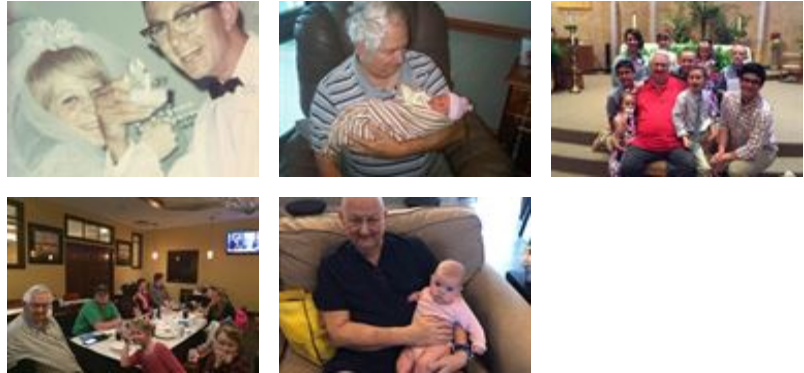

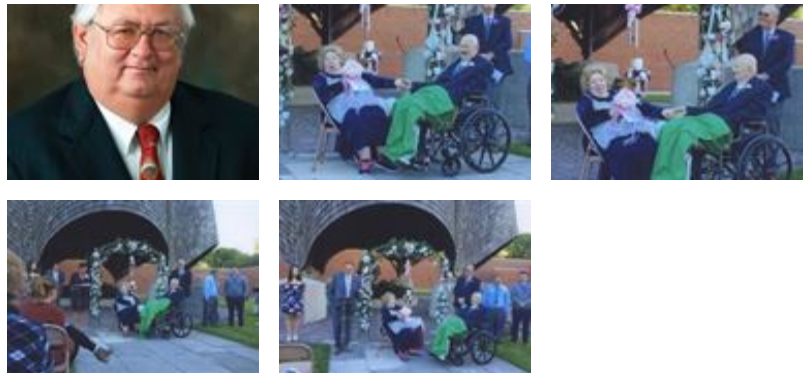
