Amy Renae (Koch) Kirsch, 43, of Evansville, passed away Thursday, June 20, 2019 in Pagosa Springs, CO as the result of an accident while on vacation.

Amy was a member of Resurrection Catholic Church, a 1994 graduate of FJ Reitz High School and a 1997 graduate of the University of Southern Indiana.

Amy loved the beach, dancing, traveling with her family, the outdoors, camping, photography, and gathering with friends and family. She worked as the Lead Educational Coordinator for the Respiratory Therapy Department at Deaconess Hospital; she loved her job and her coworkers.

Surviving Amy are her husband of 21 years, Michael Kirsch, Jr.; two daughters, Victoria and Samantha Kirsch; a son, Nicholas Kirsch; her parents, Raymond and Sylvia (Mayse) Koch; one brother, Gary (Stephanie) Koch and many nieces and nephews.

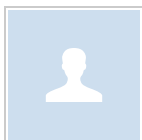
