Andy's journey through life was marked by achievement and meaningful connections. After earning his Bachelor of Science in Business at the University of Southern Indiana, he pursued further education and earned his Masters in Business Administration at Campbell University in North Carolina. His career path led him to the Tampa Bay Rays Baseball team, where he worked for several years. But it was his desire to share knowledge and inspire others that ultimately led him to find fulfillment in the field of education, teaching Business Courses for middle school and high school students. In recent years, Andy taught Business courses at the Combined School in Elko, Nevada, where he was committed to shaping young minds and empowering students to reach their full potential in the business world.

A driving force in Andy's life was his passion for running. From his early days

running cross country at Mater Dei High School, where he was recognized with the Kiwanis Leadership Award, he cultivated a genuine love and talent for the sport. This passion continued to grow during his time at the University of Southern Indiana and throughout adulthood, as he embarked on an ambitious journey to complete a full marathon in every state.

With sheer determination and adventurous spirit, Andy progressed with steadfast commitment toward his dream of completing a full marathon in all 50 states. He had recently completed his 27th marathon in Anchorage, Alaska, his 26th different state; a true testament to his resilience and dedication. Each marathon brought him not only the joy of running but also the opportunity to explore the beauty of various National Parks, combining his love for running with a deep appreciation for nature and travel.

Andy's legacy will be one of hard work, devotion, a quick wit and a gentle spirit that brought joy and comfort to those around him. His quiet confidence and ability to connect with others made him a blessing to his family, students, and friends alike. Andy's spirit will forever run alongside us.

There will be a Memorial Mass held at 11:00 AM on Friday, August 11, 2023 at St. Anthony Catholic Church, Rev. Theodore Tempel and Deacon Tom Goebel officiating. Burial will take place in St. Joseph Cemetery.
