Andrew Joseph Wildemann, 86, of Mt. Vernon, passed away, Sunday, January 21, 2018 at Deaconess Hospital Midtown Campus.

Andy was born May 17, 1931 in Evansville to the late Andrew John and Mary T. (Wannemuehler) Wildemann. He worked for Deig Brothers Construction before retiring in 1997. Andy was a 1949 graduate of Memorial High School; a member of St. Philip Catholic Church, the St. Philip Men's Club, Western Hill Country Club and the Knights of Columbus. He was a veteran of the United States Army serving in Korea; a member of VFW Post #1114. One of the highlights of 2017 for Andy was participating in the Honor Flight in May.

Surviving Andy are his wife of 63 years Mary (Ramsey) Wildemann; two daughters, Rhonda (Urban) Schenk of Mt.
