Andrew Koenig, 92, of Evansville, passed away, Thursday, June 4, 2009 at Deaconess Hospital.

Mr. Koenig was God's faithful servant and a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church. He enjoyed working as a volunteer with the St. Vincent de Paul Society. He was a Master Sergeant in the U. S. Army during World War II and was awarded a Bronze Star.

He was employed at Whirlpool Corporation as a Mechanical Engineer for 30 years before his retirement in 1984.
