Anna Jean Reine MacGregor, 83, of Evansville, passed away at 8:33 p.m. on August 24, 2014 at Heritage Center Nursing Home.

Ann was born on September 1, 1930 to Theresia (Koressel) and Henry J. Reine. Growing up on West Virginia St. as the eleventh of twelve children, she attended St. Boniface Grade School and Reitz High School. After working in manufacturing and retail sales, Ann was employed by EVSC as a remedial math tutor and as a school bus attendant. Ann then became a very skilled bookkeeper, performing that service for several local businesses before her retirement.
