



## Annette C. Goedde

July 15, 1935 - September 29, 2025

Annette Goedde (nee Wannemuehler) passed away on September 29, 2025, at the age of 90. She is survived by her eight children, Brenda (Tim) Born, Deb (Mark) Garvey, Steve Goedde, Mike (Soozie) Goedde, Don (Ginny) Goedde, Kathy (Vince) Boots, Julie (Mike) Sellers, and Chris (Leslie) Goedde, and by 24 grandchildren and 32 great-grandchildren.
