



Avila Fehrenbacher

December 19, 1917 - December 13, 2010

Avila E. (Hoefling) Fehrenbacher, 92, of Evansville, passed away, Monday, December 13, 2010 at Parkview Care Center. Avila was just six days shy of her 93rd birthday.

Mrs. Fehrenbacher had been employed at Mead Johnson for four years and with the EVSC for 15 years in the cafeteria at Cynthia Heights School. She was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Vanderburgh County, the Alter Society at the church and the St. Ann's Auxiliary at St. Wendel Church. Avila enjoyed quilting, cooking, gardening and going to Saturday evening dances with her husband. She was dearly loved and will be greatly missed by everyone that knew her.

She was preceded in death by her husband, James E. Fehrenbacher in 2001; a daughter, Susan Gardner; a son, Glen "Frog" Fehrenbacher and her twin brothers, Earl and Merl Hoefling.
