Barbara Ann “Barb” Getz, 87, a resident of Mt. Vernon, IN, passed away early on Friday, February 14, 2025, at the Mt. Vernon Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

Barbara was born on March 10, 1937, in Akron, OH. She is the daughter of the late Mary Margaret and Ernest Summerton and the widow of the late Charles L. Getz, whom she married in 1956 at St. Bernard Catholic church in Akron, OH.
