



## Barbara T. Muensterman

March 18, 1933 - April 18, 2019

Barbara Teresa (Moers) Muensterman, 86, of Evansville, passed away Thursday, April 18, 2019 at the West River Health Campus surrounded by her family.

Barbara was born March 18, 1933 in Evansville to the late Leo and Florence (Schmitt) Moers. She, along with her husband Jim, owned and operated the Hilltop Inn from 1977 to 1999.
