Bart A. Kercher, age 54, of Evansville, passed away Wednesday, April 15, 2015 at his home.

Mr. Kercher had worked at Berry Plastics and was a member of the American Society for Quality. Bart was an active volunteer with Boy Scout Troop #358 at Corpus Christi. He was a 1978 graduate of Mater Dei High School, a 1982 graduate of Purdue University and earned his Master's Degree from the University of Southern Indiana.

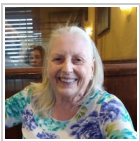
