



## Bernard Anslinger

May 14, 1918 - February 22, 2009

Bernard F. Anslinger, 90, of St. Wendel, passed away Sunday, February 22, 2009 at Pine Haven Health and Rehabilitation Center.

Mr. Anslinger was employed at the United States Postal Service for 31 years before retiring in 1978. He was an active member of St. Wendel Catholic Church, the Knights of St. John at St. Wendel and was the Secretary of the Saint Vincent de Paul Society at the church for over 30 years. In 2000, he was inducted into the Evansville Catholic Diocese Brute Society. Bernard served his country as a member of the United States Army and was the first person from Evansville drafted during WWII. He was also a member of VFW Post #6576, where he served as Quarter Master for over 20 years, the American Legion Post at Poseyville and the National Association of Retired Federal Employees.

Surviving are his wife of 61 years, Malinda (Goedde) Anslinger; six daughters, Betty Herr of Chandler, Rita (Mike) Schnur of Newburgh, Connie (Jeff) Taylor of Wadesville, Diane (Jim) Stone, Marcia (Gil) Jochem and Ruth Richmond all of Evansville; two sons, Jerry (Pat) Anslinger of Wadesville and Eugene Anslinger of Evansville. Also surviving are a sister, Margaret Zirkelbach of Evansville, seventeen grandchildren and three great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by two brothers, Edward and Walter Anslinger and a son-in-law, Andy Herr.

Funeral services for Mr. Anslinger will be held at 10:30 A.M. on Wednesday at St. Wendel Catholic Church, Rev. Ed Schnur officiating. Burial will follow in the

church cemetery where VFW Post #6576 will conduct military rites.

Friends may visit with the family from 2:00 until 8:00 P.M. on Tuesday at Pierre Funeral Home, 2601 W. Franklin Street, where a memorial service will be conducted by the church at 4:00 P.M. Friends may also visit with the family from 10:00 A.M. until service time on Wednesday at the church.
