Betty J. Faver, 97, of Evansville, went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, September 12, 2024 at the West River Health Campus.

Betty was born on March 8, 1927 in Evansville to the late Jack and Willie (Cates) Grisham. She worked for the Evansville Courier and Press for 42 years before retiring and prior to that had worked in the Evansville Shipyards on the LSTs. Betty was a longtime member of St. Philip Catholic Church, Riverbend Association Auxiliary, VFW Post 1114 Auxiliary, Twin Towers, River City Eagles and Germania Maennerchor. Betty was a Kentucky Colonel and volunteered at Deaconess Hospital as a Pink Lady for over 25 years.

In addition to her parents, Betty was preceded in death by her husband of 53 years, Charles R. Faver in 2006; by two brothers, William "Bill" Grisham and Alva "Jack" Grisham and by sisters, Virginia Miller, Alma Nickens and Doris Coomes.

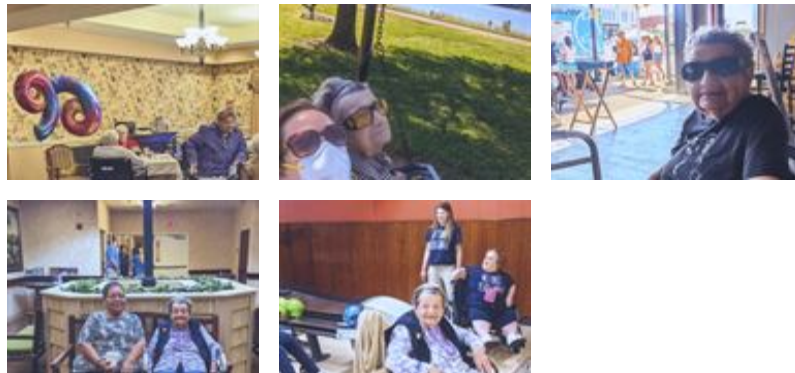
