Bonita L. “Bonnie” (Kissel) Wannemuehler, 85, of Mt. Vernon, passed away on Sunday, July 20, 2025, with her family by her side.

Bonnie was born on October 7, 1939, in Evansville to the late Elmer and Pauline (Ralph) Kissel.

Bonnie was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother. She was the matriarch of her family, making sure traditions and time spent with family always continued.
