



Brandon Boots

June 17, 1979 - August 8, 2023

Ira Brandon Boots, 44, of Evansville, passed away on Tuesday, August 8, 2023 at his home.

Brandon was born June 17, 1979 in Evansville to Ira Gerard and Terry (Seib) Boots. He was a 1998 graduate of Mater Dei High School and earned his doctorate in Physical Therapy from St. Louis University. While at Mater Dei, Brandon was an accomplished athlete leading the state of Indiana in receiving yards in 1997. He was also a two-time state place winner in wrestling and was inducted into the Indiana High School Wrestling Hall of Fame with other members of the Boots family. Brandon was an avid Notre Dame football fan; but his greatest love was his time spent coaching his two girls in basketball and softball and together they earned several state titles. He also enjoyed time spent fishing and playing clabber with his dad and fishing with his daughters.

Surviving Brandon are his wife of 17 years, Lindsey (Kissel) Boots; two daughters, Addison and Brylee Boots; his parents, Ira Gerard and Terry Boots; sister and brother-in-law, Andrea and Dan Baumann; his grandfather, Ralph Seib; father-in-law and mother-in-law, Rick and Jody Kissel; two brothers-in-law and their wives, Andy and Jodi Kissel and Zak and Aly Kissel as well as nieces and nephews, Brody, Alessia, Camden, Grayson and Hadley Baumann, Chloe, Louie and Molly Kissel and Logan and Christopher Kissel.

Brandon was preceded in death by grandparents, Florence Seib and Joseph and Dorothy Boots.

There will be a Mass of Christian Burial held at 10:00 AM on Monday, August 14, 2023 at Corpus Christi Catholic Church, Rev. Christopher Droste and Rev. Tyler Tenbarge officiating. Burial will follow in St. Joseph Cemetery.

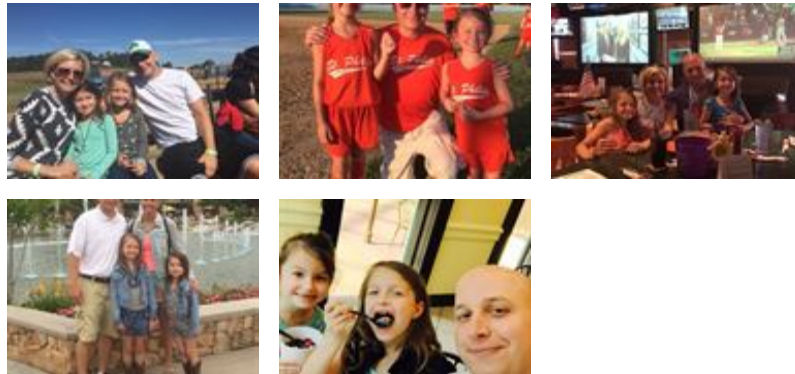
