Brenda Jean Bergwitz, 79, of Evansville, passed away Thursday, April 15, 2021 at the Linda E. White Hospice House surrounded by family.

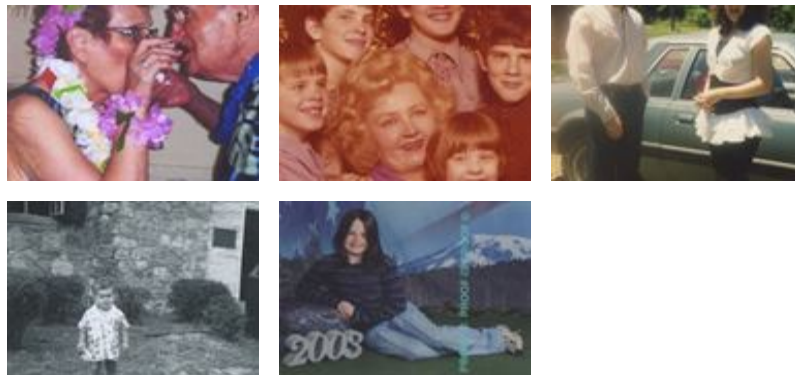

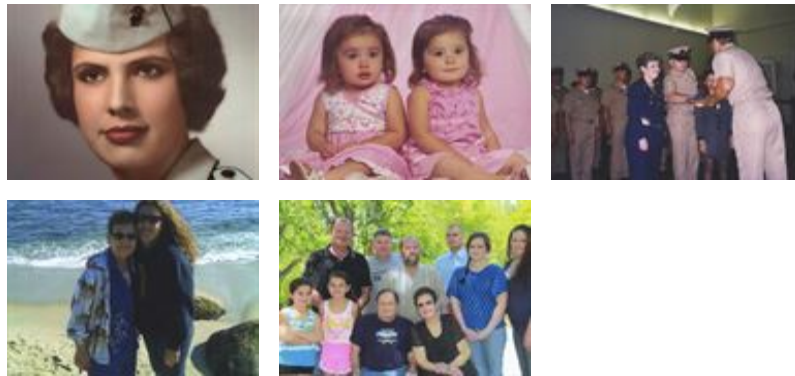
