Bruce B. Clevenger, 76, of Evansville, passed away Saturday, February 22, 2020 at Deaconess Hospital Gateway Campus.

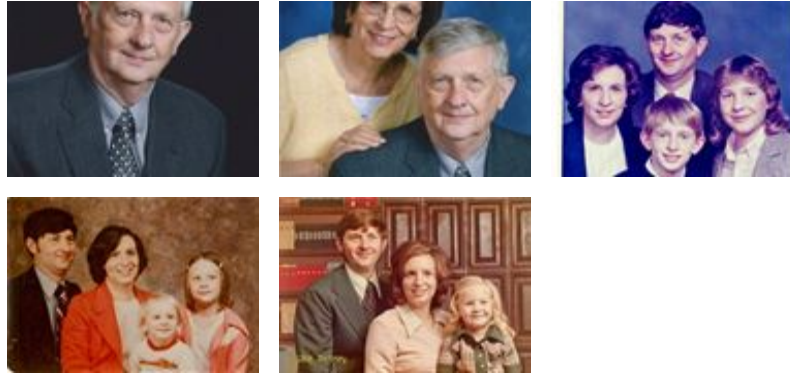
