



## Carl Baumgart

March 24, 1911 - May 7, 2012

Carl J. Baumgart, age 101, of Evansville, passed away Monday, May 7, 2012 at the Pine Haven Health and Rehabilitation Center.

Mr. Baumgart was a farmer and a member of St. Wendel Catholic Church, the Knights of St. John at St. Wendel and the Knights of Columbus. Carl was very talented working with his hands and enjoyed building things made from steel and wood. He also enjoyed fishing, St. Louis Cardinals baseball and Indianapolis Colts football. Carl was the 1934 and 1935 Golden Gloves boxing champion in the heavyweight division and was known as "One Round Baumgart".
