Carl Eugene Hamilton, Sr., 90, of Evansville, died Monday evening, February 27, 2012 at his home surrounded by his loving family.

He was born in Olney, Illinois on May 19, 1921 to Herbert and Bernice Hamilton. He worked on the family farm until joining the U.S. Navy in 1943.
