Carol Ann Grannan, 76, of Evansville, passed away at Deaconess Hospital Gateway Campus on Sunday, February 26, 2023.

Carol was born April 3, 1946 to the late Norman Graper and Marcella (Maurice) Montgomery. Carol attended St. Anthony Elementary and was a 1964 graduate Rex Mundi High School.

She began her working career at Indiana Bell Telephone as a phone operator, then worked as an administrative assistant at Shane Manufacturing, Mt. Vernon Junior High School, Lensing Wholesale and The University of Southern Indiana. She worked as an assistant at the Indiana State Teachers Association serving teachers in Gibson, Pike, Posey, and Warrick County before retiring in 2009. Carol was an active member of St. Boniface/St. Agnes Parish and received the Brute` Society award for her dedication and service to the church.

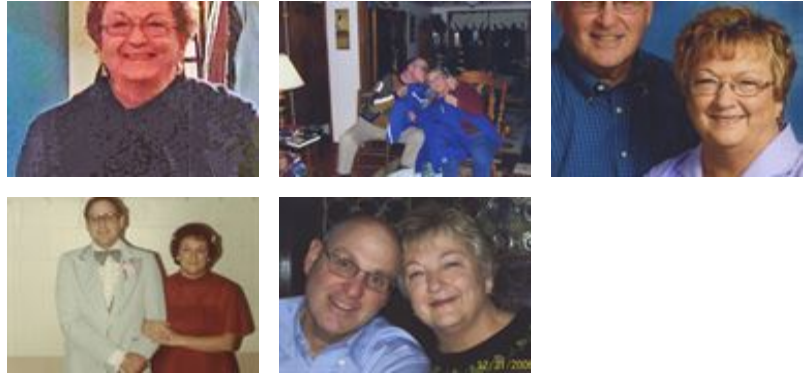
