Carol Money, 75, of Evansville, passed away Wednesday, February 24, 2021 at the Linda E. White Hospice House surrounded by family.

Carol was born May 2, 1945 in Evansville to the late Clarence “Dick” and Loretta (Wannemuehler) Weinzapfel. She taught at both St. Philip and St. Anthony grade schools for many years and later worked as a library assistant at Willard Library.
