



## Charles "Eddie" Geis

Charles Edward "Eddie" Geis, 77, of Evansville, passed away Thursday, October 18, 2018 at the Linda E. White Hospice House.

Eddie was born July 15, 1941 in Buckskin, IN to the late Herbert and Mary Lois (Weller) Geis. He was a 1959 graduate of Elberfeld High School and a member of St. James West United Methodist Church and the Crusader's Class at the church. 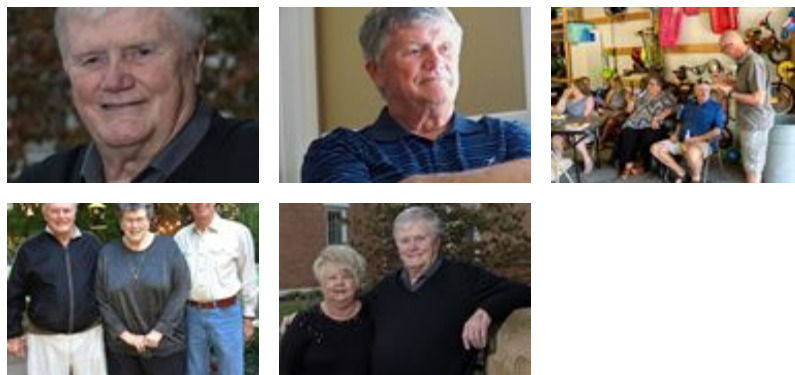
