Charles Herrmann, 86, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, April 26, 2009 at Select Specialty Hospital.

Mr. Herrmann was an electrician and had been employed at Bucyrus-Erie for seven years before retiring from S.I.G. & E. Co. in 1985 after 37 years of service.
