Charles E. "Mike" Loeffler, age 88, of Henderson, passed away Thursday, February 27, 2014 at his home.

Mr. Loeffler was born January 18, 1926 to the late John and Katherine (Schele) Loeffler in Evansville.

Mike retired from the Henderson County School System after 32 years of service. He was a life member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Evansville and a 1944 graduate of Reitz High School. Mike was a veteran of the United States Army Air Corps serving in the Pacific Theatre during World War II. He was also a member of VFW Post #1114 and a Kentucky Colonel.

In addition to his parents, Mike was preceded in death by his companion of fourteen years, Lucille Browder and his sister, Alvina Loeffler.
