



Charles Timothy Turpin

September 27, 1945 - March 7, 2024

Charles Timothy “Tim” Turpin, 78, of Evansville, passed away Thursday, March 7, 2024 at Ascension St. Vincent Hospital.

Tim was born on September 27, 1945 in Evansville to the late Jack William and Anna (Shroat) Turpin. He was a veteran of the United States Air Force and served during the Vietnam War. Tim owned and operated Speedy Oiler on Bellemeade Ave for many years before retiring. He was a member of Chapel Hill Church in Henderson, Kentucky. Tim loved to play golf and spending time with his grandchildren.

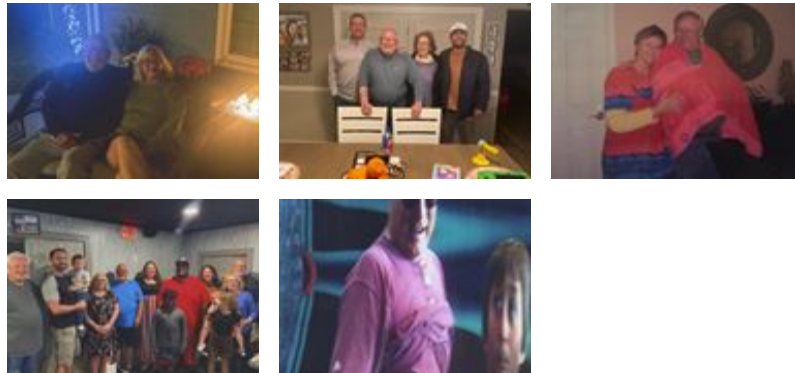
