Charles E. Welch, age 63, of Marion, KY, passed away Sunday, March 13, 2011 at the Crittenden County Hospital.

Mr. Welch had recently retired from the Kentucky State Penitentiary as a corrections officer. He had also worked as a licensed auctioneer in Kentucky and Indiana. Charlie served his country as a veteran of the United States Navy and was a member of Creekside Baptist Church in Marion, KY.
