Charles Wolf, age 84, of Evansville, passed away Saturday, October 22, 2011.

Mr. Wolf was a lifelong farmer and enjoyed woodworking and making furniture. Charles loved music. In the past, he directed the St. Joseph County Church choir, played the violin and many other instruments, and also pursued musical instrument making. He made several violins and a cello. Charles passed his love of music to his children and grandchildren, a precious gift that will continue for generations. Charles was a veteran of the United States Army and had served during the Korean Conflict.
