Charles A. "Art" Eagan, age 91, of Evansville, passed away on Tuesday, November 17, 2009 at Pine Haven Health and Rehabilitation.

Mr. Eagan had served on the Evansville Police Department for 23 years before retiring from St. Mary's Medical Center in the security department. Art was a veteran of the United States Navy, serving during World War II.
