



## Clarence Neumann

June 19, 1920 - August 3, 2010

Clarence Alexander Neumann, age 90, of Evansville, passed away Tuesday, August 3, 2010 at the Pine Haven Health and Rehabilitation Center.

Mr. Neumann was a member of Resurrection Catholic Church. He had served his country as a member of the U.S. Army during WWII in Headquarters Company 35 Tank Battalion 4th Armored Division. He was a life member of the VFW Post #1114. Clarence owned and operated Neumann's City Service at the corner of St. Joseph and Pennsylvania Avenue for 10 years; he retired from Bristol-Myers Squibb July 1, 1987 after 20 years.

Clarence is survived by his wife of 54 years, Rita (Herrmann) Neumann; two sisters, Bernice McClure of LaPorte, IN and Marietta Horne of Evansville; a sister-in-law, Arlene Epley of Evansville and nieces and nephews.
