



Clarence Schmitt

July 4, 1921 - July 7, 2009

Clarence G. Schmitt, age 88, of Wadesville, passed away Tuesday, July 7, 2009 at the Deaconess Hospice Care Center.

Clarence was born July 4, 1921 to the late Edward and Laura (Knapp) Schmitt.

Mr. Schmitt operated his own farm in Wadesville before retiring in 1979. Even after his retirement he continued to help his sons' farm until 2007. Clarence was a member of St. Wendel Catholic Church, a life member of VFW Post #6576 in Wadesville, Knights of St. John at St. Wendel and the Eagle's Country Club #427 since 1948. He also served on the FSA Committee, formerly the ASCS Committee in Mt. Vernon for 25 years. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army, serving his country during WW II in the 4th Coast Artillery as a search light operator in the Panama Canal Zone.

Mr. Schmitt is survived by his wife of 63 years, Mildred (Martin) Schmitt; his daughter, Jennifer Lynn Egli; four sons, Larry Schmitt and his wife, Melody, Bob Schmitt and his wife, Susy, Glenn Schmitt and his wife, Brenda, and Bruce Schmitt, all of Wadesville. Also surviving are two sisters, Esther Klenck of Wadesville, Dorothy Seib of Evansville; his brother, Norman Schmitt of Wadesville, ten grandchildren and twelve great grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, Clarence was preceded in death by his sister, Leora Scheller and grandchildren, Gregory and Amy Schmitt.

Funeral services will begin at 10:00 A.M. Friday, July 10, 2009 at St Wendel Catholic Church with Fr. Ed Schnur officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery where the VFW Post #6576 will conduct military rites.
