Clarence B. Seib, 95, of rural Evansville, passed away Thursday, November 21, 2019 at the Linda E. White Hospice House.

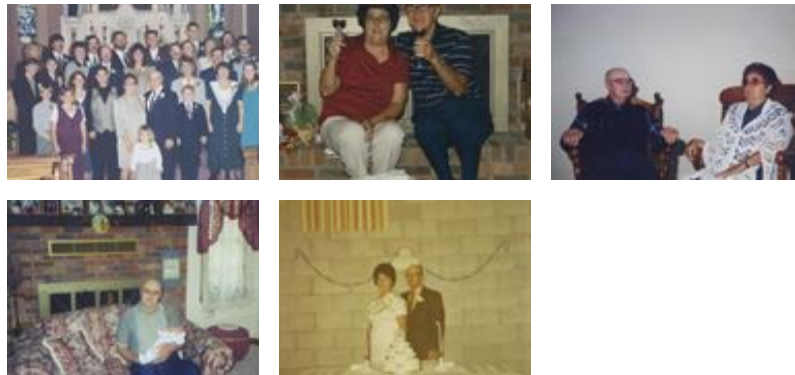

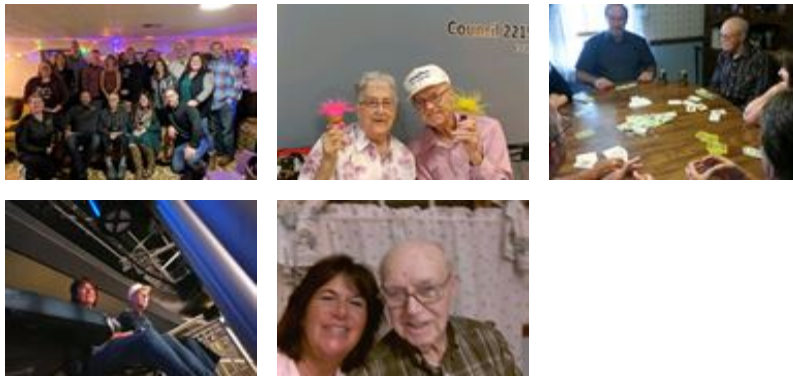

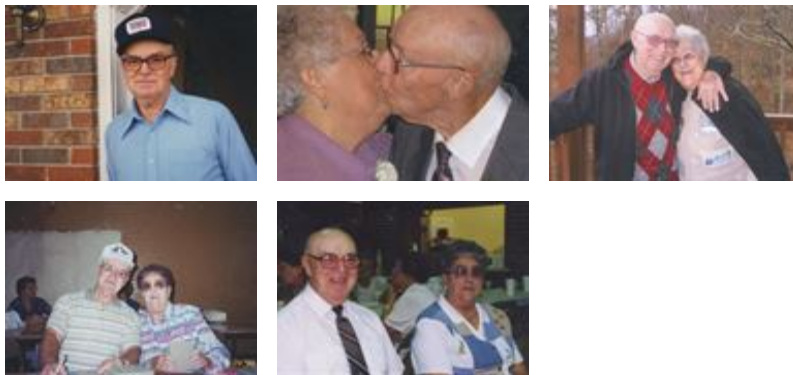
