Clarence H. "C.H." Miller, age 88, of Evansville, passed away Tuesday, May 17, 2011 at his residence at the Terrace at Solarbron.

Mr. Miller, along with his wife, Catherine, owned and operated Auto Wheel and Rim. He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Vanderburgh County and in 2010 he and his wife, were inducted into the Brute` Society. He was a founding member of the St. Joe Men's Club, a life member of the Knights of St. John at St. Wendel, the Riverbend Association and Funkhouser Post #8. C.H. was a veteran of the United States Army.

Surviving Mr. Miller are four daughters, Janet Miller, a Maryknoll Sister in Maryknoll, NY, Roxann Bradley of Evansville, Tammy (Paul) Burgess of Henderson and Angie (Mark) Kessler of Evansville; three sons, Ron (Donna) Miller, Jerry (Karen) Miller and Tom (Becky) Miller, all of Evansville.
