Clinton W. "Bud" Hahn, 86, of rural Evansville, passed away Saturday, October 13, 2007 at V.N.A. Charlier Hospice Center.

Bud was president and Owner of Hahn Crating Company for 37 years before selling the business and retiring in 1999. He was a member of St. Philip Catholic Church and the Men's Club at the church, St. Philip Conservation Club, West Side Optimist Club and the Evansville Kennel Club.
