



## Cornelia Agnes Altstadt

July 23, 1906 - May 23, 2014

Cornelia Agnes Johann Altstadt, age 107 years and 10 months, of Jasper, Indiana, passed away May 23, 2014.

Cornelia was a homemaker and a member of St. Boniface Catholic Church, the Ladies Auxiliary, the Altar Society and the Senior Citizens Club at the church. She was born on July 23, 1906 in Evansville, Indiana to Mary (Knapp) and George Wesley Johann. She lived most of her life in Evansville attending Assumption School and Central High School. She worked for a short time at Mead Johnson in Evansville. After her marriage to Clarence Altstadt, they moved to the Westside where they started their family. Cornelia was very active in many school and church activities at St. Boniface Catholic Church. Until the age of 97 when she fell and broke her hip, she lived alone at her Westside residence after the death of her husband in 1990. Shortly thereafter, she moved to Huntingburg where she lived with her son, Gerald and daughter-in-law, Lora. Following another fall, she was admitted to Northwood Good Samaritan Retirement Center in Jasper where she lived nine and half years. While being a resident of the nursing home, she was noted for her friendliness and her familiar greeting, "Hi kid." As Cornelia became more familiar with her surroundings she began calling the nurses and aids by her own special names. She was greatly loved by the staff and especially her young friend, Kelsey, who spent many hours with her.

Her husband, Clarence J. Altstadt, Sr. preceded her in death as well as both parents, Mary and George Johann and sisters, Irene Johann and Marie Parson.

She is survived her sons, C.J. "Lefty" (Charlene) Altstadt, Jr., of Evansville, Dr. Gerald (Lora) Altstadt of Huntingburg, Ronald J.
