Dana L. Shuler, age 60, of Evansville, passed away Wednesday, March 2, 2011 at the Deaconess Hospice Care Center.

Dana had worked as a deputy in the U.S. District Court of Southern Indiana and was a member of Turning Pointe Methodist Church. He was an avid golfer and history buff, having majored in history and criminology at the University of Evansville. Dana had served his country as a Green Beret in the United States Army and was a member of the VFW Post #1114 and the American Legion Post in Burlington, IN.
