Daniel David Neale, age 66, of Evansville, passed away suddenly on Sunday, November 15, 2015 at his residence.

Dan was born April 28, 1949 in Evansville to the late Oscar E. and Beatrice E. (Kissel) Neale. He was a 1967 graduate of Mater Dei High School, where he played the saxophone in the marching band.

Dan received his Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Arts degrees in business administration and production management from the University of Evansville, where he was on the Dean's list. He later received his Master's degree in hospital administration from the Indiana University School of Medicine in Indianapolis, IN. He was the vice president of administrative services at East Liverpool City Hospital in East Liverpool, OH and also served as the vice president of operations at Community Hospital in Anderson, IN. He was the vice president of the Regional Medical Center in Madisonville, KY and later served as the administrative director of surgical services at Deaconess Hospital in Evansville.

Dan was a past president of the Indiana Hospital Management Systems Society. In his younger years, Dan loved boating and water skiing and later in life enjoyed cooking, grilling, singing Karaoke and watching football and golf. Dan was a fan of music and he often watched his brother's band perform. He

also belonged to a vocal group who sang at local nursing homes.

Dan had a heart of gold and was always ready to help others in need.

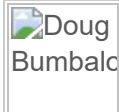
