Darrel W. Wilson, age 51, of Camby, IN, went Home to be with the Lord on Sunday, April 10, 2011 at the Deaconess Hospice Care Center.

Mr. Wilson had worked as the Assistant Director of Financial Aid for Harrison College, the former Indiana Business College, since 1994 and prior to that as the sports editor of the Perry County News. Darrel was an avid sports fan, including the Indianapolis Colts, Reitz High School Panthers and Butler Bulldogs. As a young man, he attended the Evansville United Christian Fellowship Church, where he lead youth group meetings and played several musical instruments, including the trumpet, French horn and baritone, as a young man. Darrel was a bible scholar and loved reading. Education was very important to Darrel; he was a 1978 graduate of Reitz High School and received his Associates Degree in Professional Accounting from the Indiana Business College in 1998 and his Bachelor Degree in Business Administration from Northwood University in 2000. He was loved by everyone and had a wonderful sense of humor.
